

Barbecues

Requirements

- Each barbecue needs two propane tanks. It is up to the event organizers to provide their own propane.
- Provide sufficient and sober manpower to monitor and safeguard equipment throughout the event's duration.
- Obtain any permits, licences and insurance required by municipal, provincial and federal authorities, if needed.
- Lock up in a secure area when not in use.
- Barbecue(s) must be returned in the condition it was lent out. Ie: Clean and in working order.

Width: 56"
Depth: 28"
Height: 36"

Shipping and Returning

It is the responsibility of the event organizers requesting the barbecues to arrange for one or two of their staff or volunteers to pick up, transport, and return the barbecues to ATCO Pickups and returns are during regular business hours from Monday to Friday

Pop Up Canopies

User Notes

- No cooking under canopies.
- Canopies must be dismantled each night as they can be easily damaged by wind.

Requirements

- Each pop-up canopy needs to be weighed down with stakes or sandbags. It is up to the event organizers to provide their own stakes, hammers and/or sandbags. Every leg must be staked into the ground, or have at least one sandbag

10' x 10' Dimensions

- setup - 10 feet wide on all sides
- collapsed – 1 foot wide x 1 foot high x 5.2 feet (62") long
- collapsed weight - each unit weighs approx. 75 lbs. collapsed

10' x 20' Dimensions

- setup - 20 feet wide x 10 feet
- collapsed – 1 foot wide x 1 foot high x 5.2 feet (62") long
- collapsed weight - each unit weighs approx. 125 lbs. collapsed

Shipping, Setup/Takedown

- It is the responsibility of the event organizers requesting the canopies to arrange for one of their staff or volunteers to pickup, transport, setup & sandbag (for setting up on asphalt or concrete) or stake into ground (for setting up on grass), takedown and return the canopies to ATCO
- Pickups and returns are during regular business hours from Monday to Friday

Covered Soundstage

User Notes

- The soundstage must be monitored at all times.
- The user must not dismantle, alter or modify the equipment in any manner
- Dancing on stage is not permitted

Requirements

- Uninterrupted power supply

Dimensions

The main trailer part is 23 ½ feet by 8 feet.

The drop down stage part is 16 feet wide by 6 feet deep

With the stage down its 14 feet.

The soundstage comes with

- MP3, CD & radio player capabilities — radio reception quality depends on location stage is setup
- (2) large, good quality exterior speakers on tripod-style stands
- (2) Microphones with tripod-style stands

Site Access:

This soundstage must have a clear path along a roadway for it to reach its site specific destination. This unit cannot jump curbs or go over even slightly uneven ground.

Shipping and Returning

ATCO staff will ship soundstage to and from events on a trailer unit, set up, dismantle and return soundstage back to ATCO for storage and maintenance. Security must be provided for equipment when not in use. Please make sure there is a contact on site when ATCO staff arrive.

Open Air Soundstage

User Notes

- The soundstage must be monitored at all times.
- The user must not dismantle, alter or modify the equipment in any manner
- Dancing on stage is not permitted

Requirements

- Uninterrupted power supply

Dimensions

- Ground to top of stage – 10.5 feet
- Total length including hitch – 21 feet
- Floor space – 6.5 feet wide by 15 feet long
- Width laying flat – 7 feet

The soundstage comes with

- MP3, CD & radio player capabilities — radio reception quality depends on location stage is setup
- (2) large, good quality exterior speakers on tripod-style stands
- (2) Microphones with tripod-style stands

Site Access:

This soundstage must have a clear path along a roadway for it to reach its site specific destination. This unit cannot jump curbs or go over even slightly uneven ground.

Shipping and Returning

ATCO staff will ship soundstage to and from events on a trailer unit, set up, dismantle and return soundstage back to ATCO for storage and maintenance. Security must be provided for equipment when not in use. Please make sure there is a contact on site when ATCO staff arrive.
